Our Purpose

The Florida Green Building Coalition (FGBC) is a nonprofit 501(C)3 Florida corporation dedicated to improving the built environment. Our mission is to lead and promote sustainability with environmental, economic, and social benefits through regional education and certification programs.

The way in which buildings are constructed has a huge effect on our health, quality of life and natural resources. In addition, the environmental impacts of buildings is significant to energy use, water use, and carbon dioxide emissions. Through the use of sustainable development practices and green building processes, we can greatly reduce the negative impact of the built environment on our natural resources and to building occupants.

Scholarships

The Florida Green Building Coalition (FGBC) offers student scholarships specifically to advance careers across a diverse range of green building and related sustainability areas. Individual scholarships will be awarded for up to \$1,000 to assist with tuition, educational fees, and other school related expenses. The amount and number of scholarships awarded may vary each year as determined by the FGBC Board of Directors.

Selection Criteria

Scholarship recipients are selected based on the following factors:

- Academic achievement and financial need
- Participation and leadership in community and school activities, work experience and interest in pursuing a career in green building or related industries.

Eligibility Requirements

Scholarships will be available to students entering or continuing in a higher education degree program who are pursuing a career in sustainability.

To qualify applicant must be:

- A citizen or legal resident of the United States and a resident of Florida.
- Applying to attend or currently attending a Florida public or private college or university.
- Planning to study an aspect of sustainability in the built environment.

How to Apply

To apply for an FGBC scholarship, please submit the official FGBC Scholarship Application along with any letters of recommendation available. Applications may not be mailed or faxed. Only electronic submissions will be accepted. Download the Application

Each applicant submittal must include:

- A narrative that details applicant's educational background, summary of academic interests and achievements, educational and personal goals in the sustainability field, their specific field of interest and other pertinent information. The letter should not exceed 500 words. You may include attachments.
- Two letters of reference, one character and one from an academic instructor
- Course transcript from current or most-recent institution attended.

Deadline

To be eligible for consideration, applications must be received by FGBC no later than March 31, 2016.

How to Submit Your Completed Form

Once you have completed all the requested information on the application, click on the SHARE button (not the Submit button). Then select "Attach to Email" and click on "Attach." In your email program, send to: info@floridagreenbuilding.org. Attach other supporting documents.

Recipient Awards

Scholarship recipients will be invited to attend the FGBC annual GreenTrends Conference to receive the awards and be acknowledged by industry professionals. Each award recipient will also receive a complimentary FGBC membership for one year.
