

CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

INSERVICE TRAINING

3.35

The District School Board of Putnam County, Florida supports the concept of staff improvement through the various forms of inservice training. The purpose of this policy is to establish a procedure for providing inservice training for all employees of the District.

- A. The District shall submit a master plan for inservice training based on an assessment of training needs. The plan shall be annually updated.
- B. The District shall allocate to inservice education those funds prescribed by direct support of inservice as defined by statute.
- C. The District shall participate in a multi-district Teacher Education Center established and administered in compliance with Florida Statutes:
 - 1. appoint members to the Teacher Education Center council.
 - 2. adopt a budget;
 - 3. appoint the director and staff;
 - 4. provide facilities.
