

CHAPTER 4.00 - CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

REQUEST FOR REVIEW OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

4.20

- I. Review of any instructional materials owned by the school shall follow a due process of evaluation and recommendation before an censorship results.
- II. The materials will remain in use until the final decision on the retention or rejection is made.
- III. The complainant shall submit the objection, in writing, on form D-23 provided by the principal, specifically identifying passages regarded as unacceptable.
- IV: The written complaint shall be submitted to the school principal.
- V. The school principal will submit the Request for Reconsideration of Instructional Materials, Form D-23, to the Division of Curriculum and Instruction for referral to a review committee. The review committee (elementary, middle or secondary) will be composed of representatives from (1) educational administration, (2) instruction, (3) media, (4) lay public. The review committee is encouraged to seek the opinion of expert professional people in the appropriate area under study.
- VI. The recommendation of the review committee will be submitted to the Division of Curriculum and Instruction for referral to the Superintendent and the District School Board for final action. A copy of the final disposition will be made to the individual who requested a reconsideration of instructional materials.
